This new statute is a complex piece of legislation that changes many of the fundamental principles and specific rules that govern youth justice issues, while at the same time continuing some of the features of the old law. As well as examining the new statute, the book also provides a discussion of the broader political and social issues that affect families and youth, and it explores some of the ethical and practical issues that confront lawyers and other professionals working in the youth justice system.
