



General Information for Diploma Exams

How are a student's final marks calculated?

For diploma courses, the school mark and the diploma examination mark are each worth 50% of the total mark.

How does a student get his/her results?

The Results Statement will be mailed to the student approximately three weeks after the last examinations have been written.

What if a student is ill and can't write a diploma examination that he/she is registered for?

The student should see the school administration about what to do.

What if unpredictable events such as inclement weather, fires, road closures, floods, and hazardous chemical leaks, or school emergencies occur on the day of a scheduled diploma examination?

Can a student have special provisions (accommodations) for writing diploma examinations?

Accommodations are available if a student has a special diploma examination writing need. The student should see the school counselor for more information in advance of the exam date.
