

# **Breaking Down Citations**

The following chart was created to help understand the different elements in APA citation. The following example is a Journal Article retrieved electronically, with a DOI.



### A Few More Rules

### **Citing Online Sources**

- When providing a URL, use the journal's or publisher's homepage **NOT** the link to the specific article
- **Do not** provide the name of the database you used unless you cannot find the home page URL of the journal or publisher
- APA does not require you to include the access/retrieval date
- If provided, use the DOI instead of the URL. View the DOI tutorial to learn what a DOI is and how to find it
- Accepted DOI formats:
  - O http://dx.doi.org/10.1037/rmh0000008
  - o dx.doi.org/10.1037/rmh0000008

Whichever format is chosen, remain consistent

## Capitalizing

- Only capitalize the first letter of the title and subtitle and proper nouns
- This rule only applies to titles, not journal or publisher names

#### **Bibliography Formatting**

- The first line of a source is not indented, but all following lines will be indented
