

GUIDANCE FOR SCHOOLS (K-12) AND SCHOOL BUSES

Appendix B: Management of Symptomatic Individuals and Individuals Tested for COVID-19

Symptoms	COVID-19 Test Result:	Management of Individual:
Symptomatic	Positive	Isolate for a minimum 10 days or until symptoms have improved AND no fever for 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medications, whichever is longer.
	Negative	Stay home until symptoms resolve.
	Not tested	Student: If symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath or loss of sense of taste/smell: Isolate for a minimum for 10 days or until symptoms have improved AND afebrile for 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medications, whichever is longer. Adult: If symptoms include fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, loss of taste/smell or runny nose: Isolate for a minimum for 10 days or until symptoms have improved AND afebrile for 24 hours, without the use of fever-reducing medications, whichever is longer.
		Student: If other symptoms (chills, sore throat/painful swallowing, runny nose/congestion, feeling unwell/fatigued, nausea/vomiting/diarrhea, unexplained loss of appetite, muscle/joint aches, headache or conjunctivitis):
		 ONE symptom: stay home, monitor for 24h. If improves, return when well enough to go (testing not necessary). TWO symptoms OR ONE symptom that persists or worsens: Stay home until symptom(s) resolve (testing recommended but not required).
		Adult: If other symptoms, stay home until symptoms resolve.
Asymptomatic	Positive	Isolate for a minimum of 10 days from the collection date of the swab.
	Negative	No isolation required.

SECOND LANGUAGES

STUDENT SPANISH EXCHANGE



Students studying Spanish are invited to apply for a VIRTUAL EXCHANGE, which they can do from their home, at no cost. Interested students are encouraged to apply and if accepted, they will receive a virtual partner in either Spain or Mexico. They are required to meet twice weekly with their partner, for a total of 45 minutes.

Two sessions are available:

The first session runs from November 01 - Dec 12, 2021. Application deadline is October 15, 2021.

The second session runs from February 07, 2022 - March 20, 2022. Application deadline is November 15, 2021.

This method of "exchange" replaces the actual physical exchanges we enjoyed prior to covid. However, it is a great opportunity for students to improve their Spanish and meet new people. Hopefully, in the future, students may be able to visit one another. For the moment, the global pandemic restricts our contacts.



- Enter your email (Use personal email not school email)
- Select "I'm new, sign me up!"
- Select Sign Up
- Fill in the required information that follows
- A letter that contains the signup access code is mailed to your most recent mailing address that Alberta Education has on file for you.
- This code will be sent to your home address and will arrive within 5-10 business days. Once the code arrives, you can authenticate your account from there.
- Use the Signup access code to establish your connection once you receive it.
