## 10 Steps to Becoming a RAP Student!

STEP 1	<ul> <li>MEET THE CRITERIA</li> <li>Be on track to graduate</li> <li>Have a good work ethic</li> <li>Have good people skills</li> </ul>
STEP 2	COMPLETE RESUME AND COVER LETTER
STEP 3	• Hand it in to Ms. Cadieux at the office
STEP 4	<ul> <li>COMPLETE PREREQUISITE HCS3000/HCS3010 SAFETY TRAINING</li> <li>Register in Rwn 1125 for on-line</li> </ul>
STEP 5	<ul> <li>program</li> <li>PARENTS &amp; STUDENTS ATTEND AN INFO NIGHT</li> <li>Parent awareness &amp; support is critical</li> <li>Parent/Student Information Evening</li> </ul>
STEP 6	<ul> <li>ARRANGE FOR AND ATTEND JOB INTERVIEW(S)</li> <li>Students are expected to search for work on their own. If assistance is required, RAP coordinator and/or CAREERS will assist</li> </ul>
STEP 7	SECURE FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT AND COMPLETE RAP AGREEMENT Must be completed and signed by student, employer and parent or guardian
STEP 8	<ul> <li>LEARNING PLAN TO BE COMPLETED</li> <li>Learning goals to be discussed with student, RAP coordinator and employer</li> </ul>
STEP 9	SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE 1000 Hours (obtain 40 credits).
STEP 10	<ul> <li>BECOME A REGISTERED APPRENTICE</li> <li>Work full-time/partime in a trade</li> <li>Employer agrees to begin your apprenticeship under the RAP program</li> <li>Your RAP coordinator will assist as you register on-line as an apprentice with Alberta Apprenticeship &amp; Industry and apply for blue book.</li> </ul>
