In commemoration of the NCIA's 40th anniversary, we are recognizing ten (10) high school students in Alberta's Industrial Heartland who are planning to graduate in June 2022 and attend a post-secondary institution in Alberta in September 2022 to study in a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) program, Environmental and Conservation Sciences program, or a trade.

NCIA recognizes the value and advantages of diverse ideas within our communities. The NCIA 40th Anniversary Scholarship is part of a broader commitment to equity, diversity and inclusion within our member companies to grow diversity within the fields of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics), Environmental and Conservation Sciences and the trades. We know we must increase our focus on building the future talent pipeline and find more ways to support advancing diversity in various industries.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE

Ten x \$1,000 scholarships. Scholarships will be awarded in August 2022.

NOMINATION

- Two Grade 12 students from each of the following high schools in Alberta's Industrial Heartland are invited to be nominated by their Principal, Vice-Principal or Counsellor to submit a short abstract and application form:
 - 1. Fort Saskatchewan High School (Grades 10-12)
 - 2. Sturgeon Composite High School (Grades 10-12)
 - 3. Lamont High (Grades 7-12)
 - 4. Redwater School (Grades 5-12)
 - 5. Bev Facey Composite High School (Grades 10-12)
 - 6. Salisbury Composite High School (Grades 10-12)
 - 7. Archbishop Jordan Catholic High School (Grades 10-12)
 - 8. Strathcona Christian Academy Secondary (Grades 7-12)
 - 9. Ardrossan Junior Senior High School (Grades 7-12)
 - 10. St. André Bessette Catholic School (Grades 9-12)

NUMBER OF NOMINATIONS PER SCHOOL

- Maximum of two nominees per school.
- As part of NCIA's commitment to equity, diversity and inclusion, our goal is to support advancing diversity in various industries. Students who plan to pursue a career within the fields of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics), Environmental





and Conservation Sciences and the trades are invited to submit an application form and short abstract.

ELIGIBILITY

The nominated student must:

- Be a Grade 12 student attending a high school in Alberta's Industrial Heartland (see list of schools above).
- Plan to attend post-secondary in September 2022 with aspirations to pursue a career in a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) program, Environmental and Conversation Sciences program, or a trade.
- Be an Alberta resident.
- Demonstrate academics in good standing (B grade or above).
- Submission of a 300-500 word abstract on the following:

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Submission of a 300-500 word abstract.
- 2. Application form must be filled out completely and signed by the student.
- 3. If selected for an award, students must provide proof of graduation.
- 4. Award recipients will be named in an NCIA news release and required to attend a photo opportunity in August or September 2022.

NOMINATION DEADLINE

June 30, 2022

APPLICATION DEADLINE

July 15, 2022

SELECTION AND AWARD DISTRIBUTION

- One student from each of the high schools listed will be selected for a \$1,000 scholarship following a review by the selection committee of the application form and abstract. A total of ten students will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.
- Successful applicants will be notified by phone or email.
- Scholarship awards will be distributed in August 2022.
