Eligibility Criteria Ron Kur Academic Scholarship

At the SCHS annual awards ceremony, a scholarship of \$10,000.00 will be awarded to the selected two grade 12 students who meet the following guidelines:

- (a) Applicants must have completed their grade 12 year at Sturgeon Composite High School as a full-time student (enrolled in 30 credits).
- (b) Applicants must be accepted into an accredited University and enrolled full time for September of the same calendar year as their graduation. Successful candidates must provide proof of enrollment by September 5 to receive the scholarship.
- (c) Applicants will submit a maximum 500 word essay that highlights their personal journey, community involvement, educational goals and career ambitions.
- (d) Applicants must provide three reference letters: one from the school, and two from the community. These letters will provide an additional perspective on who the student is as an individual and speak to their community and school involvement.
- (e) Applicants must provide an official transcript/Detailed Academic Record from MyPass. Applicants must meet the following academic requirements:

An average of 25 credits at the 30 level in the following courses taken at SCHS:

- English 30-1 (must be included)
- Four courses from the following:
 - Social 30-1
 - Math 30-1 or 30-2
 - Math 31
 - Second Language at the 30 level
 - Science 30
 - Biology 30
 - Physics 30
 - Chemistry 30

(f) **Formal Interview:**

Following a review of each application package as outlined above, the selection committee will interview the top candidates regarding goals, aspirations, and commitment to furthering community values.

(g) **Selection Committee:**

The committee will consist of Sturgeon Composite High School staff including administration, student services, teachers, and support staff. Successful candidates will be notified of their interview time and date by September 30.
