# Chair Report

- Meet the Teacher night was September 4. It was very successful and had a higher rate of attendance than expected. Some kinks to work out for next time but everyone was happy with the turnout.
- Cell Phone Policy-Zero Cellphones in class has gone quite successfully. Only a small number of students have not been following the new rules but the teachers and school staff are happy with the implementation.
- Letter writing campaign to our MLA re: Class sizes- Everyone in favor. Jaclyn to gather info and do up an email to be sent to parents with buzz words to use and all contact info so that it makes it easy to send for those wishing to do so.

#### **Principal Report**

- It has been a good but challenging start up. We had three staff members out on leave causing some last minute staffing changes, which are still occurring.
- We have Andrew McCann in welding, he is making some major changes to the shop as we upgrade the facility, using students to use their learned skills in the process
- Current student count is 962: 387 in grade 10; 299 in Grade 11 and 276 in Grade 12
- Classes and options are very full; we have classes in the 40s. We have identified courses in semester 2 that will need to be split if possible.
- CTS options have wait lists currently
- All teams are up and running with coaches in place
- Currently have flag football, tackle football, volleyball, golf and curling all going.
- The Hub has changed and has less supports, we have a mental health worker for 4 of 5 days and academic support for 1.5 blocks per day
- Drumline and fine arts are in full swing as well as our clubs.
- The personal Communication Device Policy (cell phone policy) is now in effect, there have been a few challenges but seems to be working well. We see less kids in the halls.
- We have a new SRO (student Resource officer) Tanner Wills. He is here two days a week and has been a great addition to our staff.
- We are still seeking sponsors for our field house. Mr Paziuk will take your money!.
- Budget is very tight this year; still predicting an increase in students next year and possibly less money again due to the three year rolling average for enrollment a well as the reduction of the bridging grant for SPSD
- The Casa Classroom is up and running with 8 students.
- Although we don't have an Indigenous Success Coach at this time, we do have a division Indigenous Education Coordinator, Maxine Hilderbrandt, working out of our room as well as Dan Lehman, our Metis Success Coach who comes in the afternoons.
- Due to the new PCD policy we will need to find more Chromebooks for classes
